

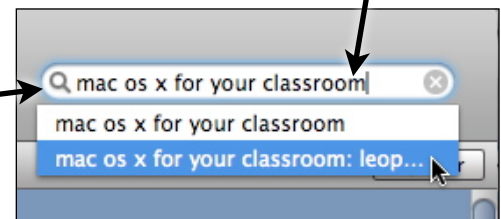
Subscribe to a Podcast in iTunes 8

A podcast is a multimedia file that is distributed over the Internet and can be played on a computer or a mobile device such as an iPod. Podcasts can be audio-only, audio with images, or video (with audio). Podcasts are usually comprised of multiple parts, called **episodes**. Users may **subscribe** to podcasts so new episodes automatically appear.

1. Launch iTunes on a Mac or Windows computer and click **iTunes Store**.



2. In the upper-right corner of the window, type a search term or the title of a known podcast.



3. When the podcast you wish to get appears, click **SUBSCRIBE**.



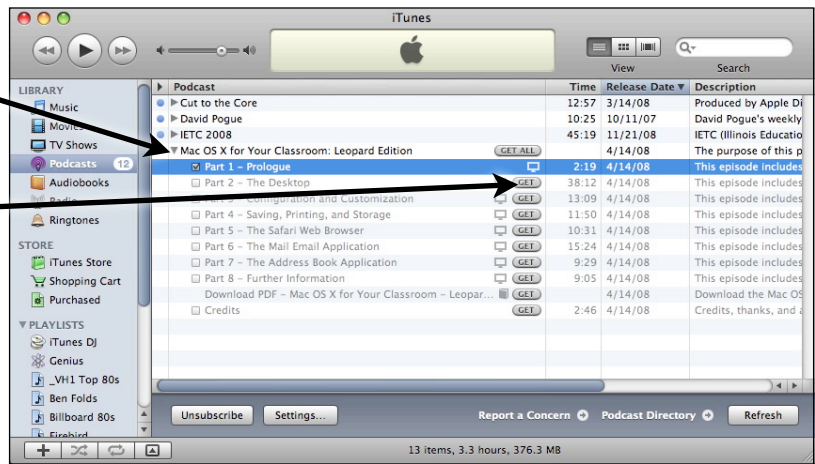
4. In the left column of the window, click **Podcasts**.



- Click the triangle to show all available episodes for a podcast.

For podcast episodes you wish to get, click **GET**.

(You may want to click **GET ALL** for all episodes to have them all available.)



- You may also search the **Podcast Directory** to see what podcasts are available for a topic.

Click **iTunes Store** to return to the store.

Click **Home**

Under the **iTunes STORE** menu, click **Podcasts**



- Under **CATEGORIES**, click **Education**.

Under **MORE EDUCATION**, click **K-12**.

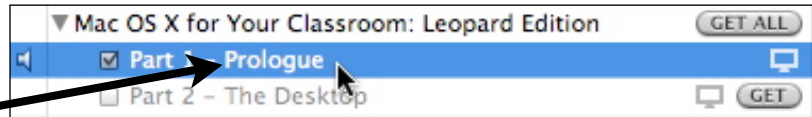


Notice the podcasts that are available. Click a podcast to learn more about it and/or Subscribe to it (as described above).

8. In the left column of the window, click **Podcasts**.



9. After you get a podcast, you may listen to it or view it.



Double-click a podcast episode to hear or see it.

While a video podcast is playing, move the mouse arrow in the window to see its controls.
